UROtech24: Abstract session Instructions

Video abstract sessions:

- Original videos will be used during the session and live attendance is required for the following discussion.
- The session will start with an introduction by the chairs. You will be called to the stage by the chairs.
- Each author will present a video of no more than 8 minutes which will be followed by 4 minutes of discussion.
- The video abstract presenters will present their video according to the order in the programme.
- Original videos will also be digitally shown in the e-poster area in the catering & exhibition area during all meeting days.

Moderated abstract sessions:

- Each author has 4 minutes of presentation which will be followed by 2 minutes of discussion.
- The session will start with an introduction by the chairs. You will be called to the stage by the chairs.
- The abstract presenters will present their presentation according to the order in the programme.

Upload presentations for moderated abstract sessions:

- You will be given the opportunity to upload your PowerPoint slides prior to the meeting via the mediAVentures link.
- The PowerPoint Template can be downloaded at "Information" on the right side of your screen.
- You will be notified via email with your personal link as soon as this service will become available.
- Please note that it is mandatory to include a disclosure slide in your PowerPoint presentation (also when you have nothing to disclose).
- You can also upload your presentation onsite in the Speaker Service Centre (SSC), at least 3 hours before your scheduled session.

Upload Poster PDF for e-poster area:

- Your Poster PDF abstracts will also be digitally shown in the e-poster area in the catering & exhibition area during all meeting days.
- Only PDF format will be accepted

- No videos are accepted
- Posters should be in landscape (horizontal)
- Posters attached to e-mails cannot be processed
- Only 1 poster PDF file per abstract

Unmoderated abstract sessions:

- Your Poster PDF will be on display from Thursday 25 January until Saturday 27 January as e-poster on electronic screens in the exhibition area.
- Only PDF format will be accepted
- No videos are accepted
- Posters should be in landscape (horizontal)
- Posters attached to e-mails cannot be processed
- 90 x 130 cm
- Only 1 poster PDF file per abstract

Do's

- > Make your poster visually interesting
- > Your poster should follow an easy to understand format i.e. methods, results and conclusions
- > Keep illustrative material simple when using charts, graphs, drawings and pictures
- > Posters should be self-explanatory and will be used to expose your findings to congress delegates

delegates

- > Use some colour combinations that provide better contrast such as white on black etc.

Dont's

- > Do not over-elaborate everything on your poster
- > It is not possible to bring small leaflets of your poster, there is no location where these can be
